## Interesting Facts about AFRICA


- Nigeria is not only the most populated country in Africa but also the 7th most populated country in the world, sporting a population of over 183 million people as of June 2015.
- Nigeria alone has over 500 different ethnic groups, each one sporting its own unique language.
- 70% of Nigerians are employed in agriculture.
- Today, Nigeria is Canada's largest trading partner in Sub-Saharan Africa. Since 2006, Canada-Nigeria bilateral trade has more than doubled, with Canadian direct investment in Nigeria at its highest level ever.
- Nigeria offers very high returns because of its growing economy; the country is in a unique position with the highest rate of returns on investment all of Africa.
- Nigeria is the 12th largest producer of crude oil in the world (averaging 2,525,000 barrels per day) and the 8th largest exporter.
- There are over 1 million Chinese citizens on the African continent. Angola alone has a population of over 350,000 Chinese.
- A lover of Social Media With over 3 million Facebook users, the youthful population of Nigeria has adopted global social media tools with enthusiasm.
